



Emeritus Status

This policy serves to supplement IFSAC Bylaws regarding Emeritus Status.

1. Individuals granted emeritus status shall:
 - a. Be invited to IFSAC conferences and meetings in accordance with the policy of his/her respective assembly.
 - b. Be allowed to speak at attended meetings with chair approval.
 - c. Maintain a non-voting status.
 - d. Be issued a certificate which denotes the effective date of the status and listed in the IFSAC member directory of each respective assembly as emeritus status.
 - e. Be able to serve on committees in a non-voting advisory capacity upon appointment by an assembly chair.
2. Assemblies may develop and adopt a policy which further defines the activities and participation for those on emeritus status who desire to remain active in his/her respective assembly.
3. Individuals awarded emeritus status shall not receive any remuneration for their services; however, they may receive reimbursement for expenses, in whole or in part, in accordance with policy developed by each respective assembly and approved by the Council of Governors. Any funds utilized for reimbursement of emeritus members shall be budgeted and approved in accordance with IFSAC financial policies.
