Summary of IFSAC-DA Most Recent Site Visit:

Kaplan University began the Bachelor of Science in Fire and Emergency Services in 2009. The program had 38 students graduate in 2016 with a 96.97% employment rate based on graduate employment survey data. The degree is housed under the same college and program director as the two degrees currently accredited. Kaplan University began the Bachelor of Science in Fire and Emergency Services in 2009. Per IFSAC policy and procedures there was no on-site evaluation of the Bachelor of Science in Fire and Emergency Services program. The administrative review process was selected because the university was already administering IFSAC accredited programs at the undergraduate level. Much of the information collected and verified in the 2015 evaluation of those programs was relevant to the bachelor program being reviewed.

Consequently, the administrative review was conducted by evaluating Kaplan University's 2016 self-study for the Bachelor of Science in Fire and Emergency Services, Kaplan University's 2015 self-study used for initial accreditation, relevant material documented by the site team that evaluated the

undergraduate degree programs including the final report and final action report recommendation, master course documents and syllabus for the additional five Emergency Management course added since the initial accreditation, and program outcomes. Kaplan University also provided access to the review their online courses.

The administrative review report used the same format as the original site team report detailed in the Degree Program Evaluator Checklist. A copy of the Degree Program Evaluator Checklist used during the administrative review to verify the program meets the IFSAC Article 23 requirements for granting accreditation is included with this report.

Based on my review, I have no requirements or recommendations. As a result, my recommendation is to grant accreditation for the Bachelor of Science in Fire and Emergency Services program.
